

### Timeline for incoming study abroad (semester 1)

<b>March/April</b>	Application form and module choices available on the Leeds Trinity University website.
<b>April/May/June</b>	Students complete application form and module choices and email to <a href="mailto:admissions@leedstrinity.ac.uk">admissions@leedstrinity.ac.uk</a> . Applications and modules reviewed and approved by academic department subject to timetable availability – once agreed no module changes permitted until arrival at Leeds Trinity.  Offer letters sent to students along with accommodation information.
<b>31 May</b>	final deadline for incoming study abroad applications.
<b>June/July</b>	Confirmation of accommodation.
<b>End Aug</b>	Intro booklets and online registration details emailed to students.
<b>Aug/Sept</b>	Students register online.

<b>w/c 3 Sept</b>	Start of academic year for Primary Education students.
<b>w/c 10 Sept</b>	Arrival in Leeds. Students living on campus should make arrangements with the Accommodation Office to collect room keys ( <a href="mailto:accommodation@leedstrinity.ac.uk">accommodation@leedstrinity.ac.uk</a> ).
<b>Fri 14 Sept</b>	Orientation meeting. Registration - students to bring passports to Student Administration (AM36).
<b>Mon 17-Fri 21</b>	Intro Week - your development tutor will advise you of your timetable by email before you arrive.
<b>Tue 19 Sept</b>	Welcome event for International students. An opportunity to meet your development tutor to discuss any questions you have and have any module amendments approved.
<b>Mon 24 Sept</b>	Teaching starts (except Primary Education)
<b>Mon 1 Oct</b>	Deadline for module amendments (using Visiting student module amendment form). This must be agreed by your home institution before submitting to Student Admin.
<b>October</b>	Once final module choices are made and signed off, students can check the term dates calendar to make arrangements for flights home: <a href="http://www.leedstrinity.ac.uk/courses/term-dates">http://www.leedstrinity.ac.uk/courses/term-dates</a> . NB If any of your modules are assessed by exams these will take place after the Christmas break.
<b>October</b>	Final learning agreements (if required) signed off by international officer.

Applications and modules reviewed and approved by academic department subject to timetable availability – once agreed no module changes permitted until arrival at Leeds Trinity.  Offer letters sent to students along with accommodation information.
<b>31 October</b>	Final deadline for incoming study abroad applications.
<b>November</b>	Confirmation of accommodation.
<b>November</b>	Intro booklets and online registration details emailed to students.
<b>Nov/Dec</b>	Students register online.

<b>January</b>	Arrive in Leeds (check your start date on your offer letter). Arrival in Leeds. Students living on campus should make arrangements with the Accommodation Office to collect room keys ( <a href="mailto:accommodation@leedstrinity.ac.uk">accommodation@leedstrinity.ac.uk</a> ).
<b>Fri 4 Jan</b>	Orientation meeting. Registration - students to bring passports to Student Administration (AM36). An opportunity to meet your development tutor to discuss any questions you have and have any module amendments approved.
<b>Mon 7 Jan</b>	Start of semester 2.
<b>Mon 14 Jan</b>	Deadline for module amendments (using Visiting student module amendment form). This must be agreed by your home institution before submitting to Student Admin.
<b>January</b>	Once final module choices are made and signed off, students can check the term dates calendar to make arrangements for flights home: <a href="http://www.leedstrinity.ac.uk/courses/term-dates">http://www.leedstrinity.ac.uk/courses/term-dates</a> . NB Your end date will vary depending on the level of modules you are taking as each level finishes at a different time.
