Smoking Policy

POLICY ON SMOKING

1. In accordance with the Health Act 2006, it is the policy of Leeds Trinity University to prohibit smoking in all areas other than the following:
2. **Smoking Areas**
 - 2.1 Smoking is restricted to designated areas of the University.
 - 2.2 It is prohibited elsewhere on the University campus.
3. **Resolution of Problems**
 - 3.1 All staff and students are encouraged to politely request anyone seen smoking in areas other than those permitted to refrain from doing so. Anyone refusing to do so following such a request should be reported to their relevant Line Manager or Student Support.
 - 3.2 Any difficulties encountered in the operation of this policy should be brought to the attention of the Chief Operating Officer and University Secretary, or to any member of the Committee.
4. **Help for Smokers**
 - 4.1 The University will provide such counselling as is necessary for smokers who wish to stop smoking, if such help is requested.
5. **Signs**
 - 5.1 **No Smoking** signs will be displayed in accordance with the Smoke-free (Signs) at each University entrance and members of the University and all visitors will be expected to observe them.
