



Regulations on Job Advertisements

Leeds Trinity University reserves the right to reject any application where:

1. The opportunity will not be relevant to any of the university's students or graduates.
2. The university is provided with inaccurate or incomplete information.
3. The job advert is misleading.
4. The advert promotes or condones illegal activity.
5. The advert requires an applicant to pay a fee in order to apply. Or where the advert requires an initial financial investment.
6. The opportunity requires the applicant to be self-employed.
7. The opportunity is connected with a pyramid (or similar) selling scheme.
8. The opportunity presents a health and/or safety risk to the applicant.
9. The opportunity involves promotes or condones academic plagiarism.
10. The advert is being placed by a private individual and not a registered company or business.
11. The opportunity fails to meet UK employment legislation, including minimum wage legislation.
12. The opportunity is commission only.
13. Reasonable adjustments are not made to ensure equal opportunities.
14. An opportunity will not provide the successful applicant with a formally written contract.
15. An advert requires the submission of a photograph of the applicant without due reason.
