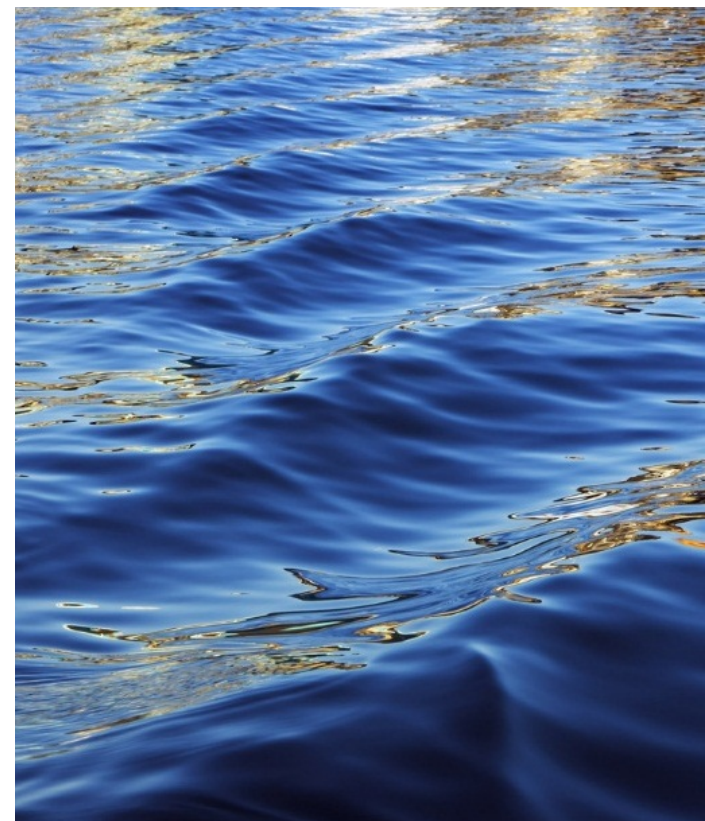

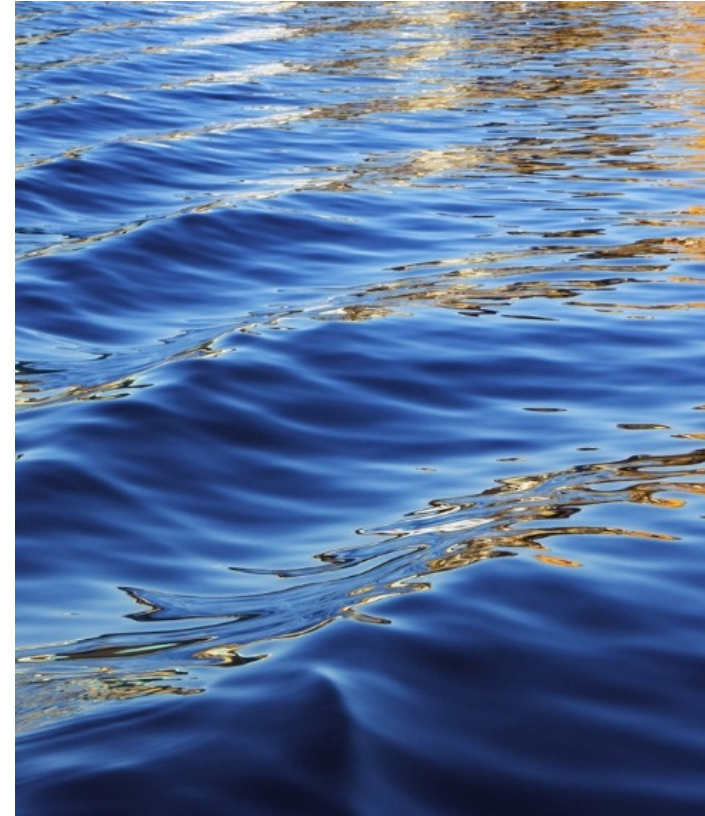

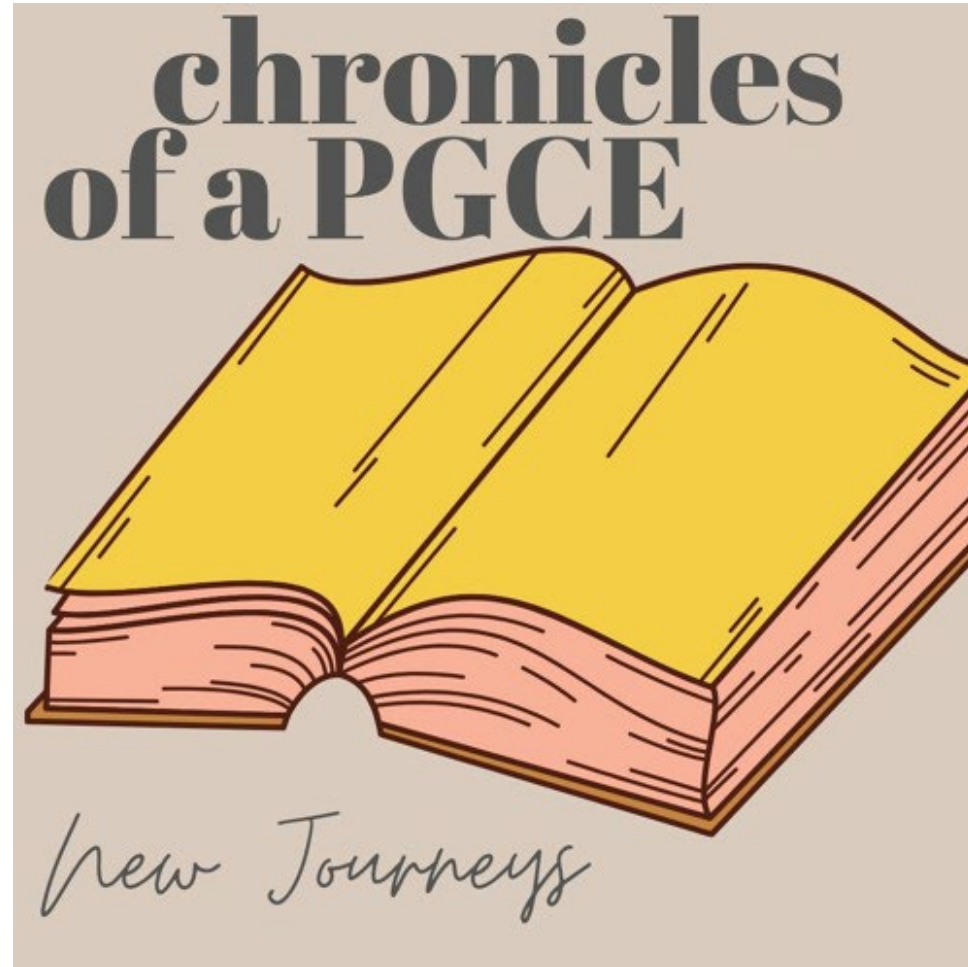


Get organised
